Spring Break 2008 on the island of Cozumel, Mexico (March 15 - 22, 2008)

Have you noticed that over the past few years we have been spending spring break on the island of Cozumel? If you have been to Cozumel you know why, if you have not, let me tell you why you should join us. Cozumel is located just 12 miles of the coast of the Yucatan Peninsula and is Mexico's largest island (at 28 miles long and 10 miles wide). The climate is subtropical and the people native to Cozumel are of Mayan Descent. The Maya were farmers, fisherman, and great warriors who ruled for over 2000 years before the Spanish arrived. The Maya were an advanced civilization who's legacy survives to this day on the island. San Gervacio is a very interesting site on the island, it was once a Sacred Site where Mayan women would worship the goddess Ixchel, the goddess of fertility. San Gervacio is now a park with a restoration project to study the Mayan culture

Cozumel was once a sleepy little fishing community until in 1961 Jacques Cousteau declared the area as one of the most beautiful scuba diving areas in the world. Now Cozumel has become an underwater marine park to protect the delicate and beautiful coral reef. The diving is spectacular, dazzling corals, abundant tropical fish, and unbelievable clarity make it one of our favorite places to dive. The island is great for non-divers too with awesome shops and restaurants in the downtown area.

We stay at The Reef Club Cozumel; this is an oceanfront complex located on Cozumel's longest beach, in the southern hotel zone about 10 miles south of the downtown area.

Beginning Openwater Classes

Divepoint continues to offer a weekend open water certification class, (not a resort course) this is an accelerated class. This course requires you to study the open water book along with the videos that are normally viewed in class. This class begins on a Friday afternoon and finishes on a Sunday afternoon. You are still required to take the four open water certifications dives after completing the class. Divepoint will continue to offer the standard six-week and three-week classes for those who do not want to rush. The cost for the complete certification is \$240.
